

Midland Park Public Schools Preschool Program 2023-2024

The Midland Park School District is accepting applications for the 3 & 4 year old general education preschool integrated program housed at Godwin School for the 2023-2024 school year. The integrated preschool program incorporates the education of special education children with that of general education preschoolers, following general education curriculum standards. The integrated preschool program is a lottery based system. Although applications are submitted, there is not a guarantee your child will be accepted. Students will be selected at random based on the number of spaces available for each session.

To be eligible, a general education child must be three or four years of age on or before October 1, 2023. (Child must be toilet trained). Children who are four years of age will attend the morning session (8:30 to 11:00 A.M). Three year old children will attend the afternoon session (12:20 to 2:45 P.M.) five half-days a week in accordance with the Midland Park school calendar. Current students will have priority for program registration. Parents will be responsible for transportation. The annual tuition for the program is \$3,250.00, either paid in full no later than September 1, 2023 or in two installments with a \$25 fee, due September 1 and January 1. All students will need to register after being selected for the integrated preschool program. At that time, the following information is required: birth certificate, copy of immunizations and proof of residency (program is only open to Midland Park residents).
