Interim Principal Cullinane introduced the new members of the administration team from the HS and current members attending tonight and provided a PowerPower presentation overviewing the proposed total remote plan for High School. Jodi Specht provided an overview of the new Student Support Center at NRHS. School Committee members ask clarifying questions on the HS presentation.
