Hot Lunch Ordering Opens Online Today

Ordering for September hot lunches and milk opens online on Monday, August 30 and ends at 11:50 p.m. on September 6. Hot lunch and milk service begins on September 20. Each hot lunch comes with milk, so do not order milk separately if you are ordering a hot lunch for your child that day. If your child is not ordering a hot lunch for the day, milk can be bought online at a cost of 75 cents. Please note that we are not accepting cash or coins, so all items must be ordered in advance online.

Students will need to bring lunch from home until September 17. Please remember to include a napkin, drink, and necessary utensils because we do not have extras at school. Please be sure students can open all containers and packages independently.

If your student forgets his/her lunch, a lunch will be provided for them. Choices include PB&J or cheese sandwich, string cheese, cheesy crackers, milk or other offerings as they are available. You will be billed \$4.00 for each forgotten lunch.
