On Friday, October 8th, please join ASCS for a fun fall evening at Three Cedars Farm! Please visit the barnyard play land, take a wagon hayride to the corn maze, or enjoy the bonfire. All of the fun starts at 6:00 p.m. and continues through the evening, so join us anytime from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Due to COVID-19, we will continue with a few changes to this year's event:

- Just like school, if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, please do not attend the event.
- We have 2 bonfire sites.
- At the bonfire, if you want to wear a mask then please feel comfortable to do so.
- The event is pre-order and on-line only (no checks or same day registration).
- We will distribute the wristbands on Monday, October 4th prior to the event via the homeroom class of your oldest child (Three Cedars Farm does not replace/refund lost wristbands).
- The cost of the ticket does not include cider and donuts. The cider and donut hut remains open during our event for you to visit.



Last year, Three Cedars Farm had a slight increase for the event of \$2/person. Since we are not including cider and donuts, the cost of the ticket is \$10/person and not \$12/person. Children age 2 and under are free. For example, a family of 4 without a child age 2 and under is \$40. A family of 4 with 1 child age 2 and under is \$30.
