Classroom Happenings



Mrs. MacKenzie's 4th grade social studies classes completed their study of maps with a group project--making a relief map of the state of Michigan. The map itself consists of salt dough, which was mixed last week, formed, and dried over several days. The groups then took turns painting the map different shades of green to represent different levels of elevation. Great job!



This week, Mrs. Zahari's 7th grade science classes used pom poms and paper gingerbread people to understand how traits are genetically transmitted from one generation to the next. By following the directions in grouping different colors of pom poms, the students developed a visual representation of how genetic traits manifest themselves over time.



Ms. Swartz's 3rd grade class is learning about vertebrates, which are animals that have backbones. To help the students visualize the structure of the human spinal column, they participated in a fun activity. Using a pipe cleaner as the spine, students added circular dry pasta noodles to represent bones, and gummy Life Savers to represent cartilage. The students were able to see how the spine is flexible, and how our bones are protected by the soft cartilage cushioning them.
