Important: School COVID Policy Updates

Please note that the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has now updated school requirements to align with current state mandates that shorten individual's quarantine and isolation periods to 5 days. Previously, we were required to keep students out of school for 10 days after becoming positive or having a close contact exposure. This revised guideline is currently being applied to all newly reported cases, and our school nurse has worked diligently to notify parents of updated return dates for students who were out previous to the change.

We were also notified by the Archdiocese of Detroit that the Wayne County Health Department is no longer requiring schools to close contact trace exposures in the school setting. This means that quarantines will continue for students exposed by household members and out of school sources when they are not vaccinated or haven't had a positive PCR in the last 90 days. However, we will no longer be conducting contact tracing for student exposures that occur at school (e.g., lunchroom, classroom, and most after school activities.)

For the next two weeks, please continue to closely monitor your students daily for symptoms. The number of covid cases reported to the school has thankfully begun to slow over the last week. However, we do expect larger than usual numbers of positive cases and quarantines from family exposure to continue across grade levels in the weeks to come. Parent class/grade level email notifications of positive cases will resume once the number of reported cases is again more isolated.

Classroom Happenings

On Monday, January 10, 2022 the 6th grade students celebrated their annual Greek Day after covering Ancient Greece in history and literature. The students studied the structure of the Greek polis (city-state) and patriotism and how its structure influenced our modern American democratic government. The students discussed the Grecian ideal of the well-rounded individual and worthy citizen and the contributions of Socrates, Plato and Aristotle, and Greek architecture.

In literature, the 6th grade students studied Greek Mythology and read sections of Homer's The Illiad and The Odyssey.

To culminate this unit, Greek Day was action packed with activities that included Olympic Games in the gym in which teams were divided into city-states of Ancient times. The students processed down the hall to the gym carrying their city-state banner and entered the gym to Olympic music while 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students cheered them on.

Later in the morning students returned to the classrooms to activities that included mosaic art projects, designs on terracotta pottery, Zeus is on the Loose card game that ties together math and knowledge of Greek Mythology, and the opportunity to create their own Greek Mythological creature.


Substitute Teacher Duties and Responsibilities:





The 2022-2023 tuition is \$6,065 per student, with a cap of \$15,195 for a family of three and \$16,985 for a family of four or more students in grades kindergarten through eight. The **non-refundable** student fee is \$425 per student in grades kindergarten through eight.

Tuition Payment Plan Options

All Saints Catholic School will be using the FACTS Tuition Management program for electronic administration of our tuition collections for the 2022-23 school year. Payment plan options allow for 1, 2, 4, 10 or 12 payments. Families choosing multi-month payments **must** use this payment program, and we would like to request that single-pay families use the system as well. There is a one-time charge of up to \$50 per year per family to cover the cost of administering the program for the year. Single payment contract options occur in June and have no administrative fee. All balances spread over two months or greater will begin payment withdrawals in July. You may choose to have your payment taken out of your checking or savings account, or charged to a credit card for an additional fee, on either the 5th or the 20th of each month. All charges are posted to the FACTS system, so a paper invoice will be issued only upon request.

Service Hours

All Saints Catholic School requires all of our families to participate in 10 hours of volunteer service (5 for single parent households) each school year. Uncompleted service hours as of May 31, 2023 will be billed to families at \$20 per hour, payable before June 30, 2023. Please log hours at www.allsaintscs.com/service.

Family Assessment Fee (per family)

Families are required to pay an annual family assessment fee of \$500 per family, beginning when the first student is in kindergarten. This fee is an Archdiocese of Detroit requirement as each family's contribution to pay down the building debt. This assessment is payable to All Saints Catholic School and subsequently submitted to the Archdiocese of Detroit. The annual family assessment fee will be invoiced in early fall and will be due by November 30th.

Tuition Policy

All previously invoiced tuition and fees must be paid in full by June 30, 2022 in order to be assured of re-enrollment.

Tuition payments begin in July for the 2022-2023 school year. Tuition paid is non-refundable. If a withdrawal is necessary due to a transfer out of the area or some other extraordinary event, pending approval by the principal, tuition will be prorated on a monthly basis. This proration will be based on the twelve month Archdiocese of Detroit school year beginning July 1st and ending June 30th.

Past Due Tuition Policy

1. The parent/guardian of the student who signs this Tuition Agreement is financially responsible for all tuition payments. *In the case of divorced or separated families, division of costs between parents, spouses, and others are between the parent/guardian and those other parties, not between All Saints Catholic School and other parties.*
2. All Saints Catholic School has the right to make all efforts to collect past due tuition and/or fees. A seriously delinquent account may be turned over to the school's attorney for collection.
3. It is imperative to meet with the school accountant in the event tuition becomes near 30 days past due. The financially responsible parent/guardian must then submit a remedial payment plan in writing to the accountant.

Enrollment in classes is contingent upon receipt of this completed tuition agreement form, payment of the non-refundable student fee, and satisfaction of all prior financial obligations to the school. Please sign this agreement and return to the school office by January 21, 2022. Thank you!
