

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL DISTRICT VOTE OF THE WEST IRONDEQUOIT CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, TOWN OF IRONDEQUOIT, MONROE COUNTY, NEW YORK, HELD AT THE ST. PAUL BLVD. FIRE DEPARTMENT, 433 COOPER ROAD, IN SAID SCHOOL DISTRICT ON TUESDAY, MAY 16, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 a.m. Chairperson Susan Russotti opened the polls at 6:00 a.m. and declared the polls closed at 9:00 p.m.

Chairperson Russotti announced that the purpose of the meeting was to vote on the proposed budget for the 2017-2018 fiscal year and to elect two members to the Board of Education.

Patricia Kelly, School District Clerk, announced that the qualifications of voters at the school district meeting and the notice of meeting were posted at the St. Paul Fire Blvd. Department, 433 Cooper Road, Rochester, NY. The legal notice had been published, as required by State Education Law, four times during the seven weeks immediately preceding the vote, in the DAILY RECORD and the ROCHESTER BUSINESS JOURNAL.

Election Inspectors, Chief Inspector Susan Bottazzo and Chairperson Russotti reported that the voting machines were in order, ready for use and that public counters were set at zero.

Upon completion of tallying the votes by the Chief Inspector, Chairperson, District Clerk and witnesses, the following is the statement of canvass of the voting results as recorded by the Inspectors of Election.
