## IMPORTANT TEST INFORMATION

The **PSAT** will be offered October 15<sup>th</sup>. Register at the Campus Center Bookstore from September 21<sup>st</sup> - October 7<sup>th</sup>. It is recommended that all juniors take the **PSAT** as this test is also used as the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship Program.

**The National Achievement Scholarship Program**, conducted by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation, is a privately financed competition established to provide recognition for outstanding Black American high school students. Black American students may enter both of NMSC's competitions for recognition and awards by taking the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT). However, entry to the National Achievement Program must be specifically requested on the test answer sheet.

**SAT deadline** - October 7<sup>th</sup> for the Nov. 5<sup>th</sup> test

**ACT deadline** - November 4<sup>th</sup> for the December 10<sup>th</sup> test

Stop into the College & Career Center to pick up registration packets and preparation booklets.

**The College Board has introduced important changes for registration for SAT testing for Test Security.**

**The College Board requires:**

- You will be prompted to provide an **acceptable photo** during registration. The photo will appear on your Admission Ticket.
- You must present your Admission Ticket with your acceptable photo ID to enter your test center. **No ticket, no ID, no admission!**
- Standby test-takers will not be admitted. (Online requests for **waitlist status may be possible** until about five days before the test.)
- **Changes** to test center, test date or test type **will not be permitted on test day**. They will have to be submitted about two prior to test day.

**Admission Ticket Photo Guidelines:**

- You are responsible for providing an acceptable photo when you register. To be acceptable, it must:
- Be clear, properly focused and correctly exposed
- Be taken in full-face view, directly facing the camera
- Match how you will look on the day of the test and in your photo ID
- School or government issued

- Original and valid (unexpired)
- In good condition and exactly matching the information you provided at registration.

**You will be turned away if your photo does not meet the requirements.**
