JUNIORS

COUNSELOR CLASSROOM VISITS

Part of the survey we do in class will ask you to indicate the college you are attending or if you need a final official transcript sent anywhere. If you are not in class, make sure you either meet with your counselor or see Mrs. Cook in counseling to fill out a final transcript request form.

Transcripts are finalized with senior year grades by early July.
