BOARD OF TRUSTEE GOALS

1. Continuously improve and provide a safe and secure environment for students and staff.
2. Develop and implement a comprehensive plan to meet the academic, social, and emotional needs of each student.
 - a. The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 36% to 56% by June 2024 (HB3).
 - b. The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 32% to 52% by June 2024 (HB3).
3. Increase the percentage of students who are college, career, or military ready through innovative programs and partnerships.
 - a. The percentage of graduates that are identified as meeting the criteria for CCMR will increase from 79.2% to 94% by August 2024 (HB3).
4. Develop and implement long-range facility and financial plans to meet the future needs of students.
5. Promote a supportive culture for students through parental engagement, strong community partnerships, and ongoing communication.

FOUR PILLARS FOR CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

PILLAR I: TEACHING AND LEARNING

Sweeny ISD will develop and implement a comprehensive plan to meet the academic, social, and emotional needs of each student. (Board Goal 2 & 3)

- Objective 1: Enhance vertical alignment in all curriculum areas.
- Objective 2: Outline and provide professional learning for cross-curricular instructional strategies to support literacy and numeracy development.
- Objective 3: Create campus assessments and data analysis processes and timelines to monitor student progress.
- Objective 4: Increase the percent of students who are college, career, or military ready through innovative programs and partnerships.
- Objective 5: Increase PSAT/SAT student participation and scores.
