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Our School Strategic Plan Goals

Student Achievement*	By May 2025, 50% of economically disadvantaged students will score "meets" or "exceeds" on SC Ready ELA.
Student Achievement*	By May of 2025, 55% of economically disadvantaged students will score "meets" or "exceeds" on SC Ready Math.
Teacher/Administrator Quality*	By May of 2025, the number of teacher and administrator certification/degrees/endorsements will increase from 54 to 69.
School Climate*	By May of 2025, 65% of teachers will agree on the SCDE teacher survey that relevant professional opportunities are offered.

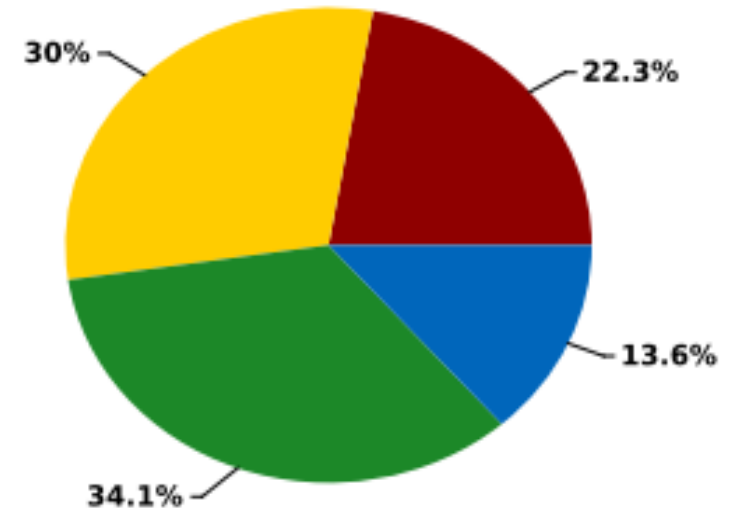

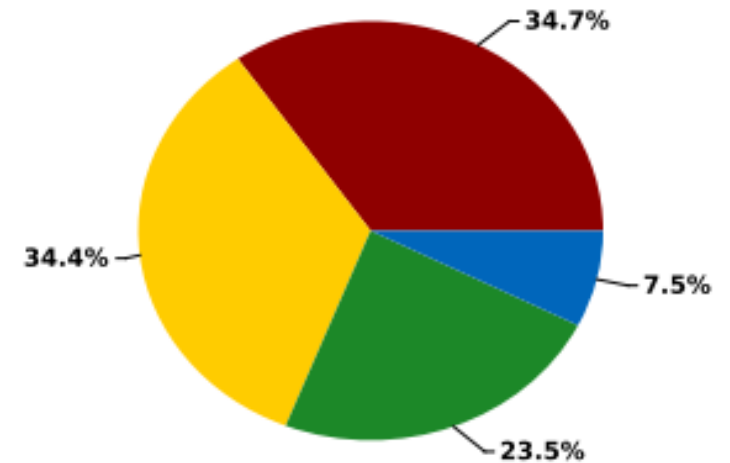
