

## TO PARENTS OF STUDENTS WHO PARTICIPATE IN INTERSCHOLASTIC SPORTS

The policy of Spartanburg County School District Four is as follows:

The District requires that all students participating in the following activities have accident insurance:

1. Interscholastic athletics on the varsity and junior varsity level and B teams.
2. Intramural football (including youth football for midgets and mites)
3. High School band.
4. Other offerings and courses as determined by the District.

This year the district has purchased insurance for athletes participating in interscholastic sports, band participants, and intramural sports. The policy is an excess policy. Under an excess policy any personal insurance is liable first for any injuries incurred and then the athletic insurance purchased by the District will cover the excess costs. Please see the attached sheet, which details the coverage limits of the policy. Please note that based on these limits it is highly unlikely that insurance will pay for 100% of an injury. Please note that amounts not covered by insurance are not the responsibility of the District.

It should be understood that the policy purchased by the District is not intended to replace any insurance that you may have or may consider purchasing for your child. Instead, it is designed to work with any insurance that you have.

We can assure you that utmost care will be taken at all times to work toward the goal that no injuries will occur. In the event that an injury does occur, claim forms will be available in the schools.
