

MCGREGOR ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT

DRUGS, ALCOHOL, AND TOBACCO

- A. All athletes must enter the random drug testing program at McGregor ISD. All athletes are bound by the rules and regulations of the McGregor ISD Drug testing policy.
- B. Alcohol and tobacco use will be dealt with as follows:
 - 1) For the first infraction, the athlete will be suspended from participation for a period of seven days and will be assigned extra running for those seven days.
 - 2) The second infraction will result in the athlete being expelled from the athletic program for a period of eighteen school calendar weeks.
 - 3) Third infraction will result in permanent removal of the athletic program.
- C. Arrests made outside of school for alcohol or drug related cases:
 - 1) First infraction, the athlete will be dealt with in the same manner as if they were caught on a drug test at school. In the case of alcohol the athlete will be dealt with in the same manner as in the alcohol policy above for a first infraction. Second infractions will be dealt with as stated in the above policy.
 - 2) Multiple outside infractions will result in the removal of the athlete from the program.

GENERAL RULES

- A. Missing Practice
As a member of any Bulldog or Lady Bulldog team, you are expected to be at every practice and meeting. If there is an emergency and you cannot attend practice, you must let your coach know as soon as possible. You must call your coach, otherwise, your absence will be unexcused.
- B. Late to Practice
Be on time to all practices so the team can stay on their practice schedule.
- C. Grades
You are in school to earn an education. You must meet all UIL eligibility requirements in order to participate.
- D. Conduct
As athletes, you are in the spotlight. Be respectful to others and conduct yourself with class at all times during school. Time spent in AEP or detention

will be considered unexcused absences.

- E. Out-of-town Trips
We represent the City of McGregor and McGregor High School. Do not do anything to embarrass yourself, your teammates, your school, or your town.
- F. Sportsmanship
Treat game officials with respect at all times. Play clean and fair.
- G. Equipment
The equipment you use is the property of McGregor ISD. Take care of it all times. Equipment is not allowed to leave the school/field house without your coach's permission. Any lost or stolen equipment will be paid for.
- H. Appearance
All athletes will be clean cut. Male athletes will not be allowed to have facial hair. All athletes are expected to set the standard for the school dress code.
- I. Profanity
Profanity will not be tolerated.
- J. Quitting
Quitting will not be allowed. If an athlete quits one sport, they will not be allowed to participate in any other sports for the rest of the school year.
