Scholarship Details

Amount of the scholarship shall be determined by the annual distribution made from the fund. Recipients are only eligible one time for the \$750 award. Funds will be made payable to the school of the recipient's choice. The scholarship is based on academic achievement and community service. Selection committee will consist of the Board of Directors of the HCAC.

Criteria

Applicant must have graduated from a high school in Ripley, Franklin, Decatur, Dearborn or Ohio County Indiana.
Applicant must be of Hispanic or Latino descent.
Applicant may be of non-Hispanic or Latino descent if they are majoring in a foreign language.
Plan to attend a two- or four-year institution of higher learning.
Must have an acceptance letter from a college or university.
Must have a grade point average of at least 2.5 (or higher) on a 4.0 scale.

Applicant Must

Complete the enclosed application.
Include a letter of recommendation from a teacher, minister, coach, or community leader.
