5 Go to your School Email
 An email should be sent to your school email. This will allow you to create your own password.
 ★ **Click on the Blue URL in the email**

6 Password
 Create a password for your account.

7 Sign in
 Go back to <https://scholartrack.che.in.gov/Login> and log into your account using:
 ★ School Email
 ★ New password you created

 Create your security questions.

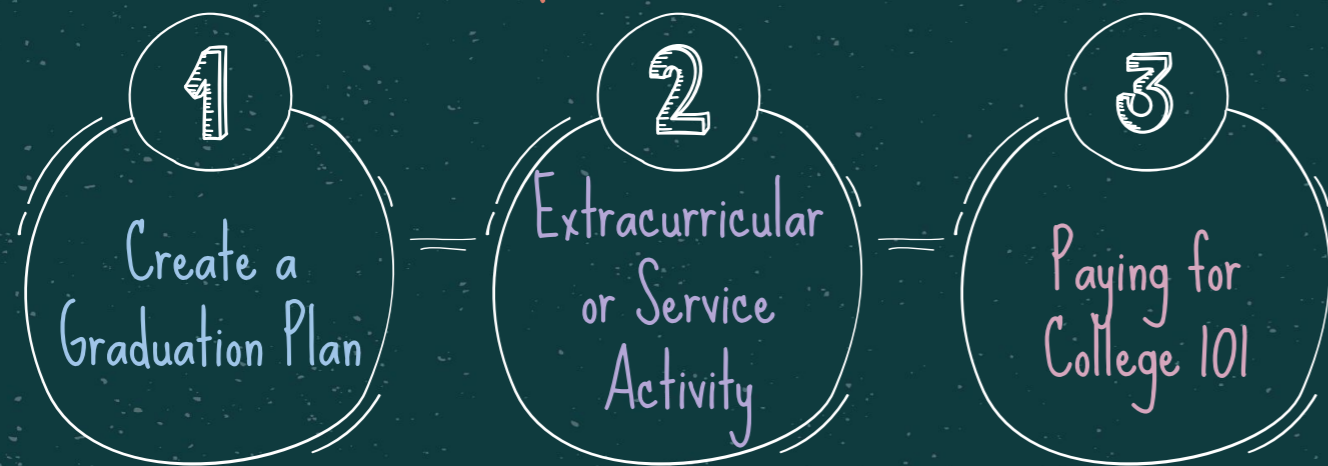

Graduate with a Core 40 Diploma or Higher and earn a 2.5 GPA or higher

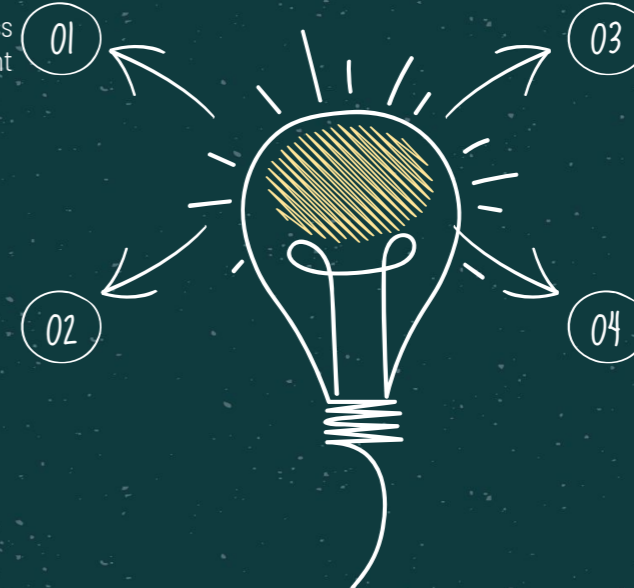
