## **2022-23 PROFILE**

Boise Senior High School is the oldest of the five public high schools in Boise, ID, and is located near the downtown core and State Capitol. Boise High is a comprehensive grade 10-12 school with a current co-educational enrollment

of approximately 1,626 students; the scholastic year is divided into two 18-week semesters. Boise High School is consistently placed among the top state and national rankings by *U.S. News & World Report* and *Washington Post* magazine.

Pandemic Report: Students ended the 2019-20 school year online; their second semester grades were based on the end of the third quarter. In 2020-21, students were in-person, hybrid, and online several times based on the severity of the Covid outbreak in our area. Students' grades were awarded as per our regular grading scale (see below). They were able to elect to be online for either semester or for the whole year. In 2021-22, school was in-person with mandatory masks for much of the year, following CDC guidelines. Currently, for the school year 2022-23, we are attending school in-person with masks optional.
