

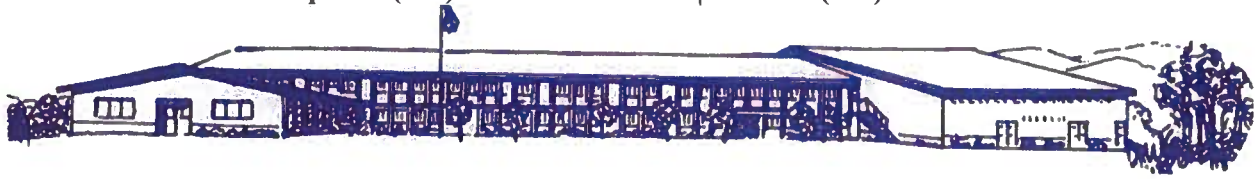

Dear Parents, Guardians, Community Members and Students,

The purpose of this correspondence is to provide you with information about the upcoming winter sports season. While we are very excited for the start of the in-door season, it is important that we do everything possible in an effort to make sure our athletes are healthy and safe to play in this COVID 19 environment.

Attached to this letter you will find three different pieces of information. Please note:

Document #1: The Superintendents and Athletic Directors of the Tri-Valley League have agreed on common protocols for teams regarding the proper wearing of face masks. Our district will be following the protocols as presented.

Document #2: This document outlines the rules and requirements for Milford Central School for both Athletes and Spectators. At this point in time, Milford is allowing all athletes, both home and visiting team, to have two (2) spectators at our games. Not all schools are allowing this. It is important that all athletes and spectators follow the COVID protocols as outlined.

Document #3: This document has been prepared by the league. It indicates which schools are allowing spectators and which are not. Please note that most schools are restricting spectators whether they are from the home or visiting team. Please know also that the limiting of spectators can change at any time due to recommendations from the Department of Health and/or the school district.

Finally, we will be live streaming all home games. The link to the games will be posted on the main page of our website.

Dear Parents and Community Members,

The Superintendents and Athletic Directors of the Tri-Valley League have agreed on common protocols for teams who are not following face mask protocols. The health and safety of our athletes, coaches, and fans are of the utmost importance to us.

1. If a player is consistently violating the mask rule, not fixing the mask in a timely manner (as soon as possible), we will talk to the coach of the player and a warning will be placed in the scorebook.
2. If the same player violates the mask rule again, and is not fixing the mask in a timely manner (as soon as possible), the Administrator on site will be notified and a second warning will be placed in the scorebook.
3. If the player violates the mask rule for a third time, and is not fixing the mask in a timely manner (as soon as possible), the player will be removed from the game and will not be allowed further participation in the game. The Administrator on site will assist with the removal and relocation (bench, locker room, etc.) of the player.

A reminder to all spectators who are in attendance that face masks must be worn covering both mouth and nose while in the building. If you cannot follow this rule you will be asked to leave the premises.

We are looking forward to watching our student-athletes compete. We are asking for your cooperation in following the protocols and expectations that have been put into place. If everyone does their part we can have a successful basketball season.

Indoor Sports Rules and Regulations
For the 2021-2022 Basketball Season

The following rules and regulations, which are specific to COVID 19 requirements, will be in effect for the 2021-2022 Basketball Season. It is assumed that all student participants will follow their home school's code of Conduct for participation in extracurricular Activities.

ATHLETES

- 1. All Athletes, both home and away, will be allowed to have two (2) spectators at each game.**
- 2. Athletes will properly wear an approved face mask and the following rules as established and supported by the Tri-Valley League Superintendents and Athletic Directors will be enforced:**
 - A. If a player is consistently violating the mask rule, not fixing the mask in a timely manner (as soon as possible), we will talk to the coach of the player and a warning will be placed in the scorebook.**
 - B. If the same player violates the mask rule again and is not fixing the mask in a timely manner (as soon as possible), the Administrator on site will be notified and a second warning will be placed in the scorebook.**
 - C. If the player violates the mask rule for a third time and is not fixing the mask in a timely manner (as soon as possible), the player will be removed from the game and will not be allowed further participation in the game. The Administrator on site will assist with the removal and relocation (bench, locker room, etc.) of the player.**

SPECTATORS

- 1. All spectators will comply with the following:**
 - A. Spectators will sign-in at each game.**
 - B. Spectators will sit in the designated seating areas.**
 - C. Spectators will properly wear a COVID 19 approved, (two or multiple layer mask) at all times on school property. Gators and handkerchiefs, and masks with vents, are not allowed. If a spectator does not have an approved mask, the school will provide one.**
 - D. Refusal to wear a mask properly, and at all times while on school property, will result in spectators being required to leave school premises.**

Dependent on the positivity rating of COVID 19 in Otego County and in Milford Central School, all requirements outlined above regarding the number of spectators allowed can change at any point in time.
