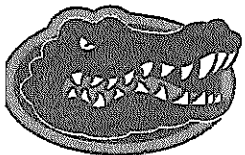

**French I – (1 unit) – 361100CW**

**Prerequisite:**

An understanding of and the ability to apply rules of grammar  
Good memorization and/or study skills

**Course description:**

This course provides practice in listening, speaking, reading, and writing in the French language. Information on francophone cultures is also provided. Course materials include textbook, and CD/DVD for listening activities and practice. Topics in this first year program include basic greetings, numbers, alphabet, places around town, school, and commonly used French verbs in the present, near future, and immediate past tenses. The goal for students completing this course is to be in the middle to high novice level by ACTFL standards. This course completes the foreign language requirement for graduation.

**French II – (1 unit) – 361200CW**

**Prerequisite:**

A completed course of French I with a passing grade (60 or above)  
An understanding of and the ability to apply rules of grammar  
Good memorization and/or study skills

**Course description:**

This course is treated as a college-preparatory course and will prepare the student for the college placement test. This course provides an opportunity to apply, to practice, and to broaden skills acquired in the level one French course. Reading and language activities will help students acquire the ability to function in the francophone culture and communicate with native speakers. The course continues to provide practice in listening, speaking, reading, and writing but uses more complex French language. Information on the francophone cultures is also provided. Course materials include textbook, workbook, and CD for listening activities and practice. Some topics in this second year program continue and build on those taught in Level 1 French. Other
